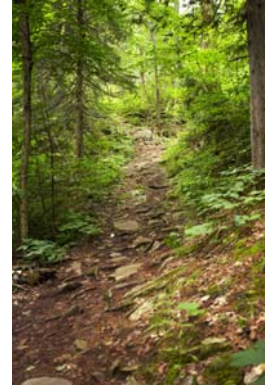

**CALL FOR ABSTRACTS**

We invite abstracts for presentations (25 minutes -- 15 minute presentation followed by 10 minute discussion) from participants registered for the Institute for Hermeneutic Phenomenology. Presentations may include sharing the findings from completed or pilot phenomenological studies, discussing particular issues in the design and conduct of such research, or exploring philosophical texts guiding research projects.

Abstracts should be no more than 300 words, typed in Microsoft Word and submitted as an attachment not later than Friday, May 2, 2008. To facilitate blind review, abstracts should be accompanied by a **separate page** include the following:

- Title of the presentation
- Author(s) name(s) and affiliating organizations
- Primary author's mail and e-mail address, phone and fax numbers
- Audiovisual requirements
