

Adolescents/Young Adults w/ Cancer: Provider Communication and Connectedness

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Abstract

Adolescents and young adults with cancer have poorer outcomes than younger children or adults. The ways in which health care professionals communicate and establish relationships with adolescents and young adults with cancer are central to identifying and addressing their needs and concerns. However, little is known about the factors and processes that influence the communication and relationship between adolescents and young adults with cancer and their health care providers. Prior to developing interventions, these factors and processes must be identified.
