SAVE THIS BLOCKING SHEET FOR FUTURE USE

1. Register via OneStart at the time of or after your registration time.
2. Register for one block only. You may not “mix” sections across blocks. If you do not register for all class numbers in the same block, your registration will be administratively canceled and you will have to re-register after all regularly progressing students have registered.
3. Only 10 students can register for each block. Begin your registration by selecting one of the practicum courses in your desired block. If that course is filled, do not register for the other courses in that block. Continue on to another class number until you find a block that has an available space and register for all courses in that block. You will need to take extreme care to register for all courses/class numbers in the block that you have selected. Check for accuracy.
4. You must have an IUPUI e-mail and password in order to use the registration system. At the time of registration classroom locations will not have been assigned. Check Oncourse prior to the first week of classes for announcements about classroom locations.
5. You may register for classes after your appointed registration time. If your appointment time falls during clinical or class time, you will not be permitted to leave to register.
6. ***Please understand that some sections may change (days, sites, times, faculty, etc.) due to circumstances beyond our control. Also, should student enrollment numbers change, it may be necessary to close a block and move students among other blocks with available spaces. We will inform students as soon as possible should a change be necessary. Announcements will be placed in Oncourse.***
7. Choose a block where you are not employed. Our policy is that if you work as a student in a clinical area you may not have your clinical in that area. It is acceptable to choose a block scheduled at your facility of employment, but not your actual unit.
8. Some S471 experiences will occur in the emergency department and a rehabilitation facility that may differ from your clinical site. We will publish the schedule as soon as possible in Oncourse.
9. You will not be able to change sections after the registration period without permission from an academic advisor and the faculty. Faculty will not give permission for changes for any reason after December 15, 2009.

Description of Clinical Sites for Spring Semester 2010

(as of 9/30/09)

NOTE: The Community Health clinical sites vary widely. Additional sites may be used which can be located on opposite sides of town in addition to what is indicated below. This clinical requires a lot of driving to the various sites. The course policy is that students may not switch sections after the first day of class. Clinical hours will vary depending on the site.

Julie Bohannon meets with her students at Nightingale Home Healthcare in Carmel, Girls Inc., Visiting Nurse Service, Northwest Hendricks county schools (Tri-West Middle School, and Wayne Township schools. Nightingale, which is located in Carmel, serves Hamilton and the surrounding counties, Marion, Hendricks, Johnson, Morgan, Boone, and Hancock.

Terrilynn Quillen meets with her students in lower Marion Couty and south in Johnson County including Franklin and possibly Edinburgh. Occasional experiences will occur with nontraditional hours, i.e. afternoons and evenings. Some school placements will require 7A-3P practicum hours. Franklin Center Township school require students to pay \$15 for their national criminal background check. Clark Pleasant schools might also be used and they require \$45 for their background check.

Elizabeth Linden meets with her students at the Martin Center and various St. Vincent clinics and sites.

Gloria Barger meets with her students at Marion County Health Department, Northwest Office.
