History of the Indiana University School of Nursing Pin

The baccalaureate pin was designed to represent the seal of the School of Nursing which was adopted in 1970, at the time of the 150th anniversary of Indiana University. The inner circle is taken from the seal of Indiana University that was adopted in 1841. The open book is symbolic of education. Lux et veritas, is Latin for light and truth, and is the motto of Indiana University. The ribbon-design border with the inscription "School of Nursing" is adapted from the original school pin.

At the bottom of the border is 1914, the year of the opening of the school. The solid border surrounding the School of Nursing seal is taken from the university seal and has the inscription "Indianensis Universitatis Sigillum MDCCCXX". The translation is "Seal of Indiana University, 1820", the founding year of the University.
